Victory Reading Program

The Victory Reading Program serves children preschool through 5th grade, residing in Gilpin Court, with extended day reading skills development. Launched in 2000 by a group of women from Victory Life Fellowship, the program has grown to serve as many as 40 children annually. Education is key to breaking the bonds of poverty and reading (language skills) is perhaps the single most important subject in the education process. Volunteers in high school or older are needed to nurture the children practically as well as spiritually while serving as tutors/mentors.

This process is unique in that our efforts provide strength to the local church's ministry and help ensure the ongoing discipleship of the kids served at camp.
